Do you or anyone you know use **OPIOIDS**?

(Opioids include: **HEROIN**, methadone, and pain medications like **OXY**contin, **PERCocet**, Vicodin, Dilaudid, and Opana.)

This training will teach you:

- How to recognize an opioid **overdose**
- How to respond by administering **naloxone** (also known as **NARCAN**)

What is naloxone?

Naloxone is a prescription medication that reverses overdose by restoring breathing and can **SAVE LIVES**.
