Calvert Alliance Against Substance Abuse	<p>Candice D'Agostino provided a written update via email prior to meeting which Pardieck provided to members at meeting.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 18,000 overdose information cards will be mailed in April to residents in Prince Frederick, Lusby, North Beach and Chesapeake Beach (2020 high overdose areas). • Ads will be placed on the grocery carts at the Weis Grocery stores in the county; the final details are being worked out. Coverage is for approximately 200 carts (full size and half size ads). The message will be the same as on the post card mailing. However, we will add a QR code to link residents to a short survey to determine their knowledge of services, etc. • Coffee sleeve advertising is a work in progress • 1,200 purple light bulbs have been ordered. Sandy and Candy will work on a distribution plan. • Drug Take Back day is April 24th from 10 am to 2 pm at Northeast, Southern and Harriet Brown Community Centers. We will collect medications and distribute resource information and Deterra Drug Disposal packets. Calvert Behavioral Health will provide Narcan training at Harriet Brown and Southern community centers. They only have staff to cover two sites.
