requesting an advisory opinion on an invitation that the Planning Commission received from the Rod n Reel Resort Team. Chairman Kete read into record the email. The email invited the Planning Commission to a tour and lunch at the new "1936" restaurant that recently opened. The Commission discussed if this would be in violation to the ethics

ordinance.

<u>Decision:</u> The consensus of the Commission was that accepting the invitation from the Rod n Reel

Resort Team for a tour and lunch would be in violation of Section §25-27 of the current

ethics ordinance. Chairman Kete will draft an advisory opinion and circulate to the

Commission for review and comment.
