Chairman Kete introduced guest Peter Feuerle, to sit in and observe the meeting. Mr. Feuerle will go before the Town Council for consideration to fill the vacancy left on the Commission.

**Item 1:** Approval of the minutes of the April 23, 2021 Ethics Commission Meeting.

**<u>Discussion:</u>** The draft minutes of the April 23, 2021 Ethics Commission meeting were presented.

**<u>Decision</u>**: The Commission unanimously approved the April 23, 2021 Ethics Commission

meeting minutes as presented.

Item 2: Approval of the minutes of the April 23, 2021 Closed Session.

**<u>Discussion:</u>** The draft minutes of the April 23, 2021 Closed Session were presented.

**Decision:** The Commission unanimously approved the April 23, 2021 Closed Session minutes as

presented.

Item 3: Approval of the minutes of the May 7, 2021 Ethics Commission meeting.

**Discussion:** The draft minutes of the May 7, 2021 Ethics Commission meeting were presented.

**Decision:** The Commission unanimously approved the minutes of the May 7, 2021 Ethics

Commission meeting.

#### Item 4: Consider for adoption certain proposed changes to the Rules of Procedure.

<u>Discussion:</u> Chairman Kete presented to the Commission the following proposed changes to the Rules of Procedure:

## 1. Section VI. Complaints

<u>Paragraph 5</u>- eliminate deadline for deciding that complaint is insufficient- remove the wording "<u>within 21 days of receipt of the complaint</u>". **Unanimously approved.** 

- 2. <u>Paragraph 6(b)</u>- clarify right to get information from Parties and the Town- Add the following wording after the word complaint, "<u>including requesting information from the Parties, the Town and others;"</u>. **Unanimously approved**.
- 3. <u>Paragraph 6</u>- Add new to this paragraph "(d) <u>Hold an informal hearing to elicit evidence and arguments from the parties." Unanimously approved.</u>
- 4. Paragraph 12- Add the following wording after the word problem "or if the respondent, even without agreement with the Commission, has taken action sufficient to remedy the problem (e.g., resigned from his or her position or ceased participating in certain matters)". Unanimously approved.
- 5. Consider adding a new paragraph #14- "Unless the Commission grants a request to keep particular documents confidential, or if the Maryland Public Information Act would preclude disclosure of a document, the complete complaint record will be made available to members of the public upon request." Commission unanimously agreed to postpone consideration of this until its next meeting.
- 6. Consider adding a new paragraph #15 "The Commission can reconsider any decision it makes under this section except if doing so would harm a party which has justifiably relied on the decision." Commission unanimously agreed to postpone consideration of this until its next meeting.

#### <u>Item 5:</u> <u>Clarify whether the definition of "children" in the Ethics Code includes stepchildren.</u>

<u>Discussion:</u> The Commission discussed whether the definition of "children" in the Ethics Code should include stepchildren. **The Commission unanimously agreed.** 

<u>Decision:</u> Chairman Kete will recommend an amendment to the ordinance to include stepchildren under this definition, at an appropriate time.

Item 6: Consider certain pending complaints and either dispose of them or decide on procedures for further consideration of them, including identifying issues that have to be resolved and information that should be obtained. A portion of this part of the meeting may be conducted in closed session.

**<u>Decision:</u>** This was previously completed, and no further action is necessary.
